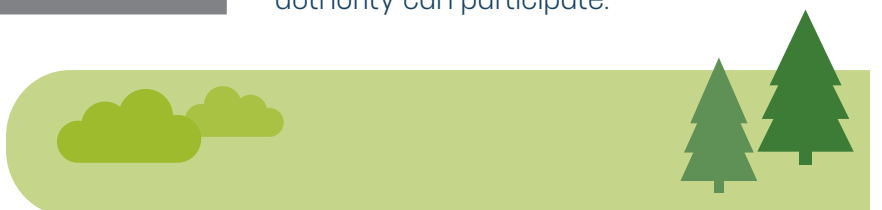




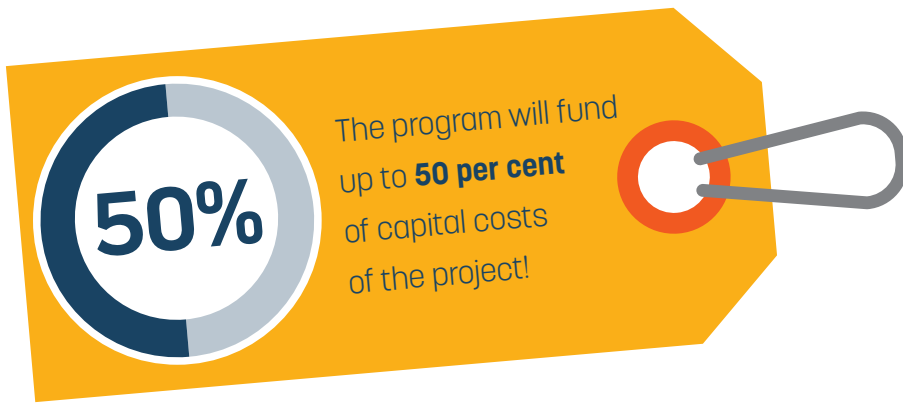

## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Solar for Schools program is intended to:

- ☀ Bridge gaps in schools' access to funding for renewable energy projects
- ☀ Offset public schools' energy costs
- ☀ Reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions associated with school's electricity consumption;
- ☀ Provide educational benefits on the issues of climate change to students in participating schools
- ☀ Increase awareness of climate change mitigation and renewable energy solutions among students, teachers and related communities.

## HOW TO APPLY

The Solar for Schools Program will provide funding to K-12 public school authorities in Alberta to install solar PV systems on existing school facilities, with a requirement to include an educational component regarding climate change mitigation and renewable energy to students in participating schools.

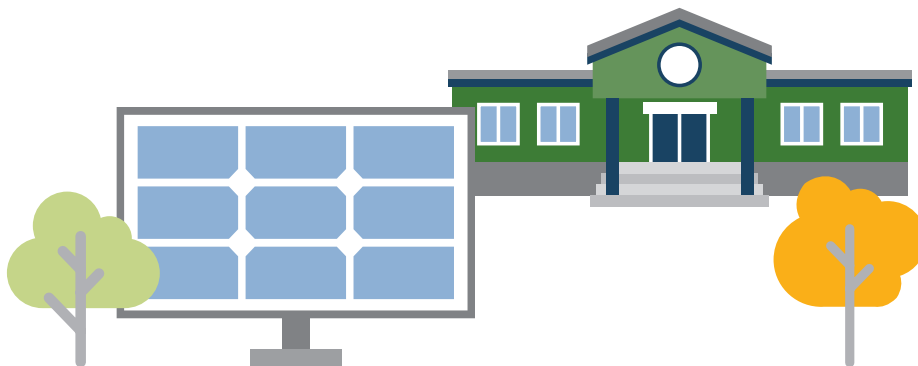

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



To be eligible, schools must:

- ✓ Serve Kindergarten (K), and/or a set of grades 1-12 and report to school authorities defined by Alberta Education as Public, Charter, Francophone, or Separate.
- ✓ Not have applied for or received funding from the Alberta Education Solar Technology System (STS) initiative.
- ✓ Be governed by a school authority/district that has not exceeded the MCCAC's program funding allocation.
- ✓ Not be eligible for the Energy Efficiency Alberta (EEA) Residential and Commercial Solar Program, Alberta Municipal Solar Program (AMSP), the Alberta Indigenous Solar Program (AISP) or Growing Forward On-Farm Solar Photovoltaics Program.

*NOTE: Schools within authorities defined as Private, Provincial, Federal, and First Nations are not eligible for the program.*
